By embracing the multidisciplinary approach of Integrated Land Use Planning (ILUP), we aim to bring an extensive range of data and expertise on bio-physical, geospatial, sustainable land management and economic information together. **Join us** in this process of knowledge exchange which can provide the basis for better informed decisions concerning the present and future use of land.

Workshop 1

Focused on stakeholders in land use planning, exchange challenges, requirements needed from data providers as well as recommendations to increase horizontal integration.

Workshop 2

Data providers and relevant stakeholders reviewing the outcomes of Workshop 1 as well as their own challenges and conceptualising their needs from land use planning stakeholders.

Workshop 3

Bringing together stakeholders from both the first and second workshop to the address the separate outcomes and develop further ideas on moving forward and creating action.

*Each Workshop will be held on a separate day in September, approx. 4-5 hours long.

The workshops will focus on **horizontal integration** between the different areas of ILUP as well as **vertical integration** to address common challenges and needs.

Long-term Objectives: The creation of Capacity Development tools (e.g., a guidebook), expanding and maintaining a network of land use planners and experts, the organization of Global Dialogue Forums where all stakeholders can come together in person to further develop common goals.
